# **Report from Pyongyang: North Korea's Nuclear Future**

*With an update about the Agreement by the two most recent  
American visitors to Pyongyang*

**Joel Wit**, a member of the State Department negotiating team on the 1994 Agreed Framework, and **David Albright**, a physicist and President of the Institute for Science and International Security, held extensive talks in Pyongyang a week before the opening of the new round of Six Party Talks. They met with senior DPRK diplomats and nuclear-related officials and were provided with updated information about the country's diplomatic positions and plutonium and weapons holdings as well as its civil nuclear program. They were told they were the first Americans to visit the country's Institute for Atomic Energy.
